



# CAMPING AT PIONEER RANCH 2021

Thanks for your interest in camping at Pioneer Ranch this summer! Your safety and the safety of our on-site staff, volunteers, and animals are a priority for us at this time.

RV spot (4 available)	\$41.00/night	Water fill up station, power hookup (110 volt)
Cabin 1	\$65.00/night	Lake front. Power, wood stove, bunkbeds, sleep 6, detached washroom/shower house.
Cabin 9	\$75.00/night	Lake front. Power, gas heater, bunkbeds, sleeps 10, detached washroom/shower house.
Lindenbach	\$110.00/night	Power, gas heater, 2 bedrooms, sleep 4, bathroom, shower, kitchen.
Infirmery	\$110.00/night	Power, gas heater, 3 bedrooms, sleep 6, bathroom, shower, kitchenette.
Castle (Cabin)	\$100.00/night	Lake view. Power, gas heater, 3 bedrooms, sleep 6, mini-fridge, ½ washroom with access to shower.
Firmament (Cabin)	\$100.00/night	Power, gas heater, 4 bedrooms, sleep 10, mini-fridge, washroom/shower.
Totem (Cabin)	\$110.00/night	Lake front. Deck. Power, gas heater, wood stove, 2 bedrooms, sleep 6, kitchenette.



### Before you arrive:

- All guests will need to fill out a short health questionnaire (including a temperature self-check) upon registering to come to camp.
- 24 hours before your arrival at camp, please call our office (403-845-6777) and confirm that you are still healthy and your arrival time.
- We are limited to groups of 10 people or less (this allows room in our numbers for other guests and our on-site staff and volunteers without going over the 50 person site maximums set by the government).

### Food/Drinks/Mealtimes:

- There will be no meals served for guests staying in rental cabins or RVs.
- 2 burner camp stoves (propane) can be rented for \$15.00 per day and include 1 16 oz. bottle of propane. (please use camp stoves *outside* cabins only)
- A takeaway lunch and or supper will be available for purchase (min. 12 hours notice is required). Each meal will be individually portioned and packed by our staff in our commercial kitchen.
  - Lunch Menu: Ham and cheese roll, apple, 2 cookies, a juice box, & a water bottle. **Price: \$10.00** per lunch.
  - Sample Supper Menus (Supper menu is subject to change, please inquire about availability) **Price: \$15.00** per supper
    - Chicken, rice and cooked veg, dinner bun, brownie, water bottle, disposable cutlery
    - Salisbury steak, mashed potatoes and cooked veg, dinner bun, cake, water bottle, disposable cutlery

### Bathrooms/Water/Power:

- RVs:
  - We cannot guarantee that there will bathroom/shower facilities available for those camping in RVs. Our bathroom facilities are reserved for guests staying in our Cabins and will be assigned by household.



- Pioneer will provide a water fill station for those guests staying in RVs
- Power hookups will be provided for those staying in RVs (110 Volt)
- Cabins:
  - Bathrooms will be assigned by household. Please use the bathroom assigned to you during the duration of your stay.
  - Cabins are equipped with power outlets and lights.
  - Cabin 1 is heated by wood stove. Cabin 9, Infirmary, Lindenbach, Totem and Castle are all heated by Gas heater.

**Misc.:**

- Please maintain a physical distance of 2m between yourself and others who are not in your household.
- Bedding will not be provided, please plan to bring your own. Guests are REQUIRED to bring their own bedding.
- Guests wishing to bring pets on-site must adhere to our pet policy (*please inquire if this applies to you*)
- Due to the current pandemic situation our main indoor common areas are *closed* to guests: Dining Hall, Clancy's corner, Nikki's Nook, Robin's Nest, Winspear Room, Laundry Room, North Lodge, Craft Palace.
- Due to the current pandemic situation our program facilities are *closed and off limits* to guests including the waterfront, archery range, climbing wall, initiative course, and barns (all horse programming, trail rides and lessons),
- We are an alcohol, illicit drugs and cannabis free site. Please refrain from bringing/using any alcohol or cannabis products or illicit drugs while on our site. Those who do not adhere to this policy will be asked to leave.
- We are a peanut and tree nut free facility. Please refrain from bringing/consuming any peanuts and/or tree nuts on our site.
- Walking and skiing trails will be open and maps can be provided if guests wish
