## Before you Arrive

All guests will need to fill out a short health questionnaire (including a temperature self-check) upon registering to come to camp.

24 hours before your arrival at camp please call our office (403-638-2660) and confirm that you are still healthy and your arrival time.

## While you are here

- We are limited to groups of 10 people or less (this allows room in our numbers for other guests as well as our on-site staff and volunteers without going over the 50 person site maximums set by the government).

### **Food/Drinks/Mealtimes:**

- There will be no meals served for guests staying in rental cabins. We are a nut free site, so please refrain from bringing any products containing nuts while on our site.

### **Cannabis/Alcohol Policy:**

- We do not allow alcohol, cannabis, or illicit drugs on site. Anyone found not complying with this will be asked to leave without refund.

### **Facilities:**

2 double Cabins and 1 Chalet

Cabins are equipped with power outlets, lights and central heating

Cabins have showers and toilets/sinks

Chalet only has a Toilet and sink (Guests are welcome to use the shower available in our Pool House next door to the Chalet)

### **Other:**

- There is firewood available to use in the outdoor fire ring and the fireplace in the chalet.
- Please maintain a physical distance of 2m between yourself and others who are not in your household.
- Bedding and linen will not be provided, please plan to bring your own. Guests are REQUIRED to bring their own bedding and towels.
- Guests wishing to bring pets onsite must adhere to our pet policy (please inquire if this applies to you)
- Due to the current pandemic situation our Main Lodge is closed to guests,
- Due to the current pandemic situation our program facilities are closed and off limits to guests including the waterfront, archery range, climbing wall, initiative course, and barns (all horse programming, trail rides and lessons),
- You may go out on the land at your own risk. Please do not interact with the horses and you must close any gate you open. If you follow the road past the climbing wall, it goes all the way to the Nitchi Creek. This is a great location for a picnic.
