## PHYSICAL DISTANCING POLICIES

We are so grateful that you have decided to give of your time and energy to help us make the Ranch we all love even better. We know things will be different during your stay here than they usually are, but we hope that even with the changes you feel welcome and blessed by your time on site. We want to be clear that the policies laid out here are for your safety, as well as the safety of our on-site staff, volunteers, and animals.

### Before you arrive:

- All guests will need to fill out a short health questionnaire upon registering to come to camp.
- 24 hours before your arrival at camp please call our office **(403-845-6777)** and confirm that you are still healthy and your arrival time.
- We are limited to groups of 7 people or less (this allows room in our numbers for on-site staff and volunteers without going over the 15 person maximums set by the government).

### Food/Drinks/Mealtimes:

- All guests and staff will wash their hands upon entering the main floor of the Ranch House (either in the dish pit sink or in the Clancy's Corner kitchenette sink)
- Hand sanitizer stations will be provided at entrances to the Ranch house. Please make these a regular stop as you pass them.
- All food and snacks will be served by one of our staff (they will be wearing a mask). Please allow us to serve you.
- We will provide you with a new plate or bowl each time you return for a second helping.
- Coffee and Tea will be served by one of our staff and will be available at mealtimes and snacks.
- All seats in the dining hall will be spaced 2m apart.



- We will have a bottle of food safe sanitizer beside the water dispensers. Please spray down the handles after filling water bottles and please avoid touching your water bottle to the water dispenser at any time.
- We will not be asking for help doing dishes after mealtimes to avoid more people than necessary entering our kitchen.

**Bathrooms/Sleeping Accommodations:**

- We will be assigning sleeping accommodations and bathroom facilities based on households.
- Please use only the bathroom assigned to your household while on site.
- Please bring your own bedding.

**While Working:**

- Please maintain a physical distance of 2m between yourself and others who are not in your household.
- We will provide masks for those working on projects in which maintaining a physical distance of 2m is difficult
