BARNS PROJECTS

Fencing Project

Safety Attire:

- Close-toed shoes (steel toe only required for those using chainsaw)
- Long pants
- Safety glasses
- Work gloves

Tools & Equipment

- Cordless drills
- Hammers
- *Personal chainsaws welcome

If Using Chainsaw, all of the Safety Attire plus:

- Ear protection
- Chainsaw chaps/pants
- Hardhat

- Post pounder (manual)
- Wire stretchers

Painting/Staining Sleigh & Wagon

- Gloves
- Painting clothes (clothes you don't mind getting paint on)

Salt Arena Project

Safety Attire:

- Close-toed shoes
- Work gloves

Tools:

- Garden rakes

Weed Spraying Project

Safety Attire:

- Close-toed shoes or rubber boots
- Long pants
- Work gloves
- Long sleeve shirt
- Safety glasses

Tools & Equipment:

- Garden variety herbicide
 - *Personal sprayers welcome

SITE PROJECTS

Bucking up & Splitting Firewood Project

Safety Attire:

- Jeans

If Using Chainsaw, all of the Safety Attire plus:

- Hardhat
- Personal chainsaws welcome

Construction Projects

Safety Attire:

- Jeans

- Steel toe boots

Tools (recommended but not required):

 - speed square, hammer, nail bar, tape measure, pencil, etc.)
