



Job Title: Cabin Leader

Reports To: Camp Director

Purpose: To care and be responsible for children ages 7-19, including their spiritual, mental and physical well-being while at camp.

Essential Job Responsibilities:

- Participate fully in all aspects of the camp program
- Attend all meals with their campers
- Attend Bible Study each morning with their campers, remembering their primary responsibility as good role models
- Engage in conversation around the Bible Study, activities and cabin specific topics
- Participate in waterfront activities with their campers
- Prepare and run cabin activities
- Be present in cabin during rest period (where applicable)
- Participate in evening programs and campfire with campers and staff
- Maintain proper discipline, obtaining assistance from camp leaders whenever it is needed
- Ensure that campers are in bed with lights out at the time specified
- Be aware of the needs and concerns of campers, ready to share those as necessary with Sectional or Camp Director
- Maintain a safe atmosphere
- Ensure that duties and cabin cleaning are carried out every day
- Report any incidents as described in the Pioneer Camp orientation

Qualifications

- Must be a minimum 17 years of age or having been through Pioneer Camp's Leaders-In-Training Program
