

Riding Out-Trip PACKING LIST

Appropriate equipment on an out-trip is a safety must.

A Note on Cotton: Cotton clothing increases the risk to a camper's well-being during their out-trip. Nylon, polyester or polypropylene clothing will help protect campers & dries quickly.

Additional Gear for Horseback Riding Out-Trips:

- Riding jeans (2 pairs) beware of jeans with a thick seam inside the knees as they can rub your skin raw over a long ride!
- Riding boots with a 1" heel (riding boots can be expensive so unless your child is an avid rider meaning (s)he will ride more than just at camp rubber boots are a great alternative.)
- Riding slicker (if you have one already)
- Good rain coat & pants essential (NO PONCHOS)
