



Job Title: Riflery Instructor (Lodge Only)

Reports to: Camp Director, Pioneer Camp Summer Director

Purpose: Plan, develop and implement an age-appropriate riflery program for the duration of the camp.

Essential Job Responsibilities:

- Responsible for the safe and effective operation of the Riflery (air-soft) Program, and its coordination into the whole camp program
- Set up and maintain safe and adequate field riflery courses
- Repair, care for, and clean riflery equipment and maintenance of current inventories
- Instruction to campers in riflery skills and formation of a schedule, in cooperation with the Camp Director and Pioneer Camp Summer Director, maximizing the use of the program
- Enforce all safety regulations as set forth by the ACA and Camp administration
- Report any individuals who refuse to follow the safety regulations
- Report any incidents according to the Pioneer Camp policies and guidelines outlined in the Pioneer Camp orientation

Qualifications:

- Must possess sound, mature judgment and possess personal integrity. Patience and a strong interest in working with youth are essential for the proper execution of the Riflery Instructor's responsibilities
- Have a strong air-soft/riflery background
- Must be willing to work hard, creating a riflery program for varied ages and skill levels
- Must be a minimum of 18 years of age
